STEP 1

Submit a Letter of Intent
due online
April 30
by noon.

The Letter of Intent is available at
www.impact100pensacola.org.

STEP 2

Grant Application due online
June 15

Organizations who submit a Letter of Intent on or before the noon deadline of **April 30**, and meet the eligibility requirements, will receive access to the online grant application.

Once submitted, the application is reviewed for completion and forwarded to the applicant's designated focus area.

IMPORTANT DATES

MARCH 19

Number of IMPACT 100 members and the grant amounts for current year are announced.

Online Letter of Intent becomes available to nonprofits.

APRIL 18

Nonprofit Workshop & Social is held.

APRIL 30

Letter of Intent is due by noon.

MAY 10

The grant application is released by May 10 to eligible nonprofit organizations.

MAY 20

Grant Application 101 Webinar is offered to those nonprofits who have submitted a Letter of Intent.

JUNE 4

Grants Q&A sessions are available to nonprofits submitting a 2023 grant application.

JUNE 15

The online grant application is due by noon.

MID JULY-AUGUST

Focus Area Committees meet, conduct site visits, and select finalists.

SEPTEMBER

The finalists are announced.

OCTOBER

Annual Meeting where each finalist presents their project and the ladies of IMPACT 100 choose their grant recipients.

NONPROFIT OPPORTUNITIES
